When it was time to name the streets, the Puritans who settled in Little Blessing in 1648 sought no further than "The Good Book" for inspiration. They dubbed the main thoroughfares after the Seven Virtues, except for Gluttony Road, of course. That unholy street was reserved for the town outcasts, the sinners who wasted their nights drinking ale and playing poker at Gluttony Tavern.

Centuries later, the town's only shopping district is located on Charity Street, across from beautiful Moonwater Beach and the Seashell Carousel. 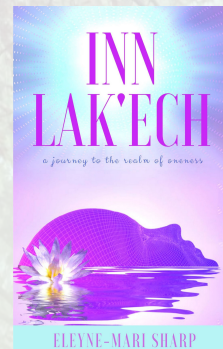
